There are no minutes for the previous meeting because the previous meeting was not a business meeting -- it was a dinner meeting at the Corner Cafe. The minutes of the previous business meeting, held in November, were published in the December issue.

Field Day Results

2018 ARRL Field Day results have been published by the ARRL. The Heart of America Radio Club operated in the 3F category, which means located at an EOC facility operating three transmitters simultaneously. This year we operated from the American Red Cross radio room, the last time at the current Red Cross office location.

The Heart of America Radio Club finished in 19th place in that category with 2102 points. That puts the Heart of America Radio Club in second place in Missouri and in the Midwest ARRL Division to the Hannibal, Missouri and Western Illinois ARC. This first and second place pairing happened before, most recently in 2016.

The 2018 Field Day results for the Heart of America Radio Club probably shouldn't be compared to previous years because of an unusual situation for Field Day this year. The air conditioning at the Red Cross was not cooling and all of the operators abandoned the operation overnight because of the heat that built up during the day.
