Fusion Intro at October Meeting

The program for the October Heart of America Radio Club meeting will be a presentation about the Yaesu Fusion System™ which permits transmission of digital voice and data and also with conventional analog FM voice capability over the VHF Amateur radio and above bands. It also can incorporate the ability to connect with internet connected systems called Wires-X™.
