## March HARC Meeting at New Location

The March Heart of America Radio Club meeting will be held Tuesday, March 19 at 7:00 pm at a new location, the relocated Red Cross office. The offices are located within the Winchester Business Park at 6601 Winchester Avenue, Kansas City, MO 64133.

There is more than one way to the location. Here is one of the routes. From Sixty-third Street, turn south on Winchester Avenue at the traffic signal. Drive up a long hill for three blocks. You will pass the Spectrum office on the right. The next building on the right is 6601 Winchester Avenue. The sign announcing the building says, SAIC. Parking space surrounds the building, but park in front. Below is a rendition of the building.



Upon entering the building, go to the hallway ahead to the left. The Red Cross area is the first office on the right.
