How About a Fox Hunt?

The program for the April Heart of America Radio Club is about fox or hidden transmitter hunting. The presenter will be Don Reed, KØIFO.

The meeting will be held Tuesday, April 16 at 7:00 pm at a new location, the relocated Red Cross office. The offices are located within the Winchester Business Park at 6601 Winchester Avenue, Kansas City, MO 64133.

There is more than one way to the location. Here is one of the routes. From Sixty-third Street, turn south on Winchester Avenue at the traffic signal. Drive up a long hill for three blocks. You will pass the Spectrum office on the right. The next building on the right is 6601 Winchester Avenue. Parking space surrounds the building, but park in front.

The front door of the building will be locked at the time of the meeting. If you arrive after 7 o'clock, call for WØRR on 146.940 MHz. simplex, because reaching the 94 repeater using an HT from inside the building is difficult. You might also use 94 simplex to obtain talk-in directions if you are close by.
